FITS: 2001-2006 GM 2500HD/3500 pickup, 2WD/4WD w/6.0L, 8.1L, crew cab short box


NOTE: DO NOT TIGHTEN ANY CLAMPS OR BOLTS UNTIL THE LAST STEP! READ THESE INSTRUCTIONS FULLY AND THOROUGHLY BEFORE YOU BEGIN.

- 1) Support the vehicle in a safe manner. We recommend using a drive on shop hoist for quickest and safest installation. If using floor jacks, support the vehicle at all four corners safely on a level surface.
- 2) You will need to remove the exhaust after the converters, but reuse some of the o.e. extension pipes on both sides. Cut both o.e. extension pipes just in front of the inlets of the muffler, we recommend using a hack saw or a reciprocating saw to cut. You may need to cut the system in a couple of pieces to make it easier to remove. You should cut 3" after the o.e. hanger that is on the passenger side just before the factory muffler.
- 3) Install the i.d. end of driver and passenger side extension pipes (they are identical) to front extension pipes using 3" clamps.
- 4) Install the muffler to the extension pipes using the 2-3/4" clamp on the driver side, and 2-3/4" hanger clamp on the passenger side. Attach the wire portion of the hanger to the o.e. mount along side the muffler inlet.
- 5) Install the tail pipe to the muffler using the front 3" hanger clamp. Attach the wire portion of the hanger to the o.e. mount above.
- 6) Install the rear 3" hanger clamp to the tail pipe. Attach the wire hanger to the o.e. mount above.
- 7) Tighten all clamps, hangers, and the bolts, and check for clearance of the body, frame, chassis and suspension members, and of the brake and fuel lines.
